

Poster Format

Poster Format:

A0 format in portrait orientation.

Layout:

To facilitate reading, it is recommended to divide the content into 2 or 3 columns.

Sections can be organized in a linear structure (following the reading direction) or a more free structure, placing the most-read sections (title, results, conclusion) at the top.

To distinguish sections, it is possible to frame each section, leaving a sufficient margin between them.

Add the logo of the University of Djibouti and the conference logo, as well as your own.

Font Size:

Use an easily readable font such as Arial, Helvetica, or Calibri.

The title should be in bold, start with an uppercase letter, and be in lowercase (avoid all-uppercase titles which are less readable). It should not exceed 1 to 2 lines.

Recommended font size:

Title: Minimum 58 pt

Subtitles: Minimum 38 pt

Text: Minimum 24 pt

Colors:

Use 2 to 3 main colors, preferably pastel (light and soft) colors.

Illustrations:

Illustrations (tables, graphs, diagrams) should use the same font as the text, preferably of similar size.

They should be understandable on their own, numbered, referenced in the text, and contain a title.
